**PROCEEDING OF THE 60<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE WODC HELD ON 30.12.2022  
AT 11.30 AM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SRI ASIT TRIPATHY, HON'BLE  
CHAIRMAN, WODC AT 6<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR, RAJIV BHAWAN, BHUBANESWAR**

The 60<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Western Odisha Development Council (WODC) was held on **30.12.2022 at 11.30 AM** under the Chairmanship of Sri Asit Tripathy, Hon'ble Chairman, WODC in the conference hall of WODC, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Rajiv Bhawan, Bhubaneswar. The list of Members present in the meeting is placed at **Annexure-I**.

At the outset, Hon'ble Chairman welcomed all Members of the Council as well as the RDC (ND), Sambalpur and Chief Executive Officer-cum-Member Secretary, WODC. Initiating the discussion, Hon'ble Chairman highlighted the steps taken by WODC since last two years to expedite the completion of the incomplete projects and strengthening the overall system of monitoring the progress. He stated that because of robust field monitoring there is appreciable progress in pace of work. The life cycle of the project has been shortened. In the earlier years projects got stuck because of land, absence of monitoring and ownership by district administration which all have improved now. Further, he stated about the speedy execution of Lower Suktel project, Lower Indra project for enhancement of irrigation facility, economic packages of the Biju Expressway corridor for boosting the development of western Odisha areas in which WODC is also playing important role.

During discussion, Hon'ble MP, Bargarh desired for convergence of WODC funds with MP LAD/ MLA LAD and other schemes so that bigger projects can be executed in the Council area. MLA, Bargarh requested for completion of incomplete WODC funded projects. Hon'ble MLA, Patnagarh requested for consideration of cold storages in the vegetable growing area of western Odisha districts. Hon'ble MLA, Khariar stated about engagement of Technical Consultant at district, so that delay on receipt of feasibility report at WODC can be minimized. Hon'ble MLA, Deogarh focused on more projects to be sanctioned for irrigation and tourism sectors in Deogarh district. The Revenue Divisional Commissioner (ND), Sambalpur stated about taking up monthly review meetings by him at district level on WODC funded projects for early completion and submission of UCs.

After due deliberation, it was decided that Feasibility Report must be ensured from the district within a period of 60 days. It was also decided that the additional technical manpower will be explored so that the monitoring/ supervision will be more effective at the district level.

Then the Chairman requested the Chief Executive Officer to initiate the discussion as per the agenda.

The Chief Executive Officer-cum-Member Secretary initiated the discussion in the meeting as per the agenda.

**1. Confirmation of the proceedings of the 59<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting Dt.06.05.2022.**

The Council after threadbare discussion confirmed the proceedings of the 59<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council.

**2. Ratification of shelf of projects under 2022-23.**

The Council after threadbare discussion, approved the shelf of projects (723 nos.) worth Rs.48,19,87,000/- under 2022-23 Grant. The detailed district wise abstract is given below.

**6. Any other matters:-**

**(i) Fixation of the headquarters of WODC**

The Chief Executive Officer, WODC placed the matter on fixation of headquarters of WODC in the meeting. During discussion, Hon'ble MP, Bargarh suggested for preparing a parameter taking into consideration such as backward area, communication facility etc. for fixation of the WODC headquarters. He stressed the need for decisive action by the Chairman/ Government in view of the prevailing lack of the consensus. However, Hon'ble MLA, Bargarh, Deogarh,


Khariar and Patnagarh suggested to establish the headquarter of WODC at their respective district headquarters. In the light of the above no decision could be arrived in the Council meeting regarding fixation of headquarters of WODC. So, the Council resolved to continue with the decision taken in the Council meetings held on 27.12.2021 regarding fixation of the headquarters of WODC.

**(ii) Project Monitoring Application (Dash Board)**

The Chief Executive Officer, WODC apprised the Council about the web enable Project Monitoring Application (Dash Board) and it's utility for observing the progress of the WODC funded projects, which was launched by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha on 21.10.2022.








